RAFFLE RULES 2026/2027 License #787054



1. This is a 50/50 raffle with draws held bi-weekly. 50% of ticket sales each pay period go to the winner with remaining proceeds to the RDRH Foundation to support the purchase of medical equipment & programs for healthcare centres in the central zone of Alberta.
2. Tickets are structured as follows: 57,200 tickets at \$5 each, 93,600 tickets at 3 for \$12 (1200 packages), 169,000 tickets at 5 for \$15 (1,300 packages), and 572,000 tickets at 10 for \$20 (2,200 packages). Total ticket value is \$2,311,400.00.
3. Buyers who pay through payroll deduction may opt out for draw dates not yet complete, with cancellation proceeding if the request is received in writing before the draw deadline and in accordance with the payroll calendar.
 - Only deductions taken on regularly scheduled pay periods will be included in the draws. Deductions will not be taken from off-cycle pays.
4. Red Deer Regional Health Foundation Staff 50/50 is open to the public. Such tickets must be prepaid.
5. If a participant has paid by auto withdrawal, credit/debit card, electronic funds transfer, cheque, or cash for their entry and they request a refund for draws not yet complete, a refund will be given if the request is received in writing at least 10 days before the draw.
6. Automatic withdrawals, credit/debit card, cheque, electronic funds transfer, or cash entries can be made for a minimum of one draw, up to all draws in the current licensing period. Payment must be received at least 10 business days prior to each draw.
7. Persons under the age of 18 years are not eligible to enter and the name of a minor must not be written on the ticket. If it is determined prior to the draw that a ticket has been issued to a minor, the ticket is deemed void and the purchaser refunded.
8. Tickets will not be sold outside the province of Alberta.
9. All sets of multiple tickets must contain the same purchaser information.
10. One winner is drawn at random at the Red Deer Regional Hospital Centre South Complex, 3942 50A Ave, Red Deer, Alberta at 9:00 a.m. every second Thursday starting September 10, 2026 running up to and including August 26, 2027, with the exception of draw #22, which will be made on Wednesday, June 30, 2027 due to the statutory holiday on July 1, 2027. Draws are open to the public.
11. The draw is video-taped. An individual with short sleeves will pull one ticket out of the entry bin. This person does not have a ticket in the draw, nor do they have interest in the draw. Two executive members of RDRHF and one member of the public will be present to witness each draw.
12. The winner has up to three months from draw date to claim the prize. If any prize remains unclaimed for more than 3 months from the date of the draw, a request will be made to the AGLC for a decision regarding the disbursement of the prize.
13. All winners are notified in person or by telephone by the Red Deer Regional Health Foundation detailing what they have won and where they can claim their prize. Also, the name and city of the winner will be published on the Foundation website site: www.rdrhfoundation.com/ways-to-give/foundation-50-50.
14. All prizes are paid to the person whose name appears on the winning ticket, either by cheque or electronic funds transfer according to the winner's preference.
15. In the event that a winning ticket stub lists more than one name, the Licensee will award the prize to the individual whose name appears first on the stub. The Licensee and Alberta Gaming, Liquor & Cannabis are not responsible for resolving any disputes that may arise between the different individuals.
